GEIS WEBSHOP

Glen Eden Intermediate School is excited to be able to offer parents online uniform purchasing with our provider, New Zealand Uniforms. Webshop allows you to purchase all your uniform from the comfort of your home and have it delivered to your door.

- NZU offer a Uniform Club card option which allows you to save for your uniform throughout the year—more information on the flyer attached.
- Payments can be made by credit or debit card, or zip (own it now, pay later) —more information on flyer attached.
- All items on the webshop have size charts to help you choose the correct size.
- If you require a quote for WINZ you can also do this online. Select the items you wish to purchase, at checkout complete your details and select "Print quote" - a quote will be emailed to you to take to WINZ who will pay directly to NZU. NZU will then process your order.

Uniform Tip #1 Buy one size bigger to allow room to grow

Purchasing online is the only option available this year.

We are hoping this new process runs smoothly, however as this is a trial

please be patient with us. We will do our best to ensure everyone is able to get their uniform ready for starting on the first day of school.

<u>Please complete your online orders by 27 January 2022</u> to ensure delivery ready for the first day of school - Year 7 students 8 February 2022, Year 8 students 9 February 2022.

WHAT TO WEAR ON THE FIRST DAY

- GEIS white polo shirt
- GEIS bottle green school culottes, skort or shorts
- Black bucket hat or cap (plain black with no logos)
- Black school shoes with white ankle socks or black sandals (see guide on P5)
- OPTIONAL—GEIS green jacket

You will also need your PE gear in your bag:

- GEIS PE Tee
- GEIS black PE shorts



PURCHASING TIPS AND GUIDELINES

CHOOSING THE RIGHT SIZE

All the items on the webshop will have a size chart to help you choose the correct size.

- For shirts and jackets compare the measurements on the size chart to items of clothing you already have.
- Half chest measurement explained:

Lay a shirt down on a flat surface and measure it from left to right across the chest, about 2cm below the arms. This is the half chest measurement of the garment. Then using the sizing information for the garment you want to order, choose the size with the closest half chest measurement to your own garment.

HOW MUCH TO BUY

This is personal choice however we suggest the following to get started:

- 2-3 polo shirts
- 1-2 culottes, skort or shorts
- 1 hat or cap
- 1 PE tee and 1 PE shorts (students will need PE gear every day for fitness however they are quick dry fabrics and dry overnight)
- 1 green jacket (although it will be summer when we first start in February, students may need an extra layer on cooler mornings)

OF Uniform Tip #2 PE Tee: a looser fit may be best

We suggest purchasing the black fleece, raincoat and scarf in term 2 when the weather changes as it is unlikely to be needed in term 1.

Uniform will be available to purchase throughout the year if you need extras or different sizes as students grow.

CLICK AND COLLECT

If you would prefer to pick up your order from school, select the click and collect option when you place your online order. There is no delivery fee for this option. Your order will be packed and sent to school and will be able to be collected from the lower school carpark/auditorium on the following days and times. <u>We will email you when your order is ready to be collected.</u>

Please ensure you have your order confirmation email with you. Please allow 2-4 days from the date of placing the order. Note: if you place your order early in January the earliest day/time for collection will be Tuesday 25 January.

RETURNS AND EXCHANGES

RETURNS:

If you need to return an item purchased from the webshop please contact New Zealand Uniforms and follow their returns process.

EXCHANGES:

You can exchange items that are in original, unwashed, unworn condition and with tags still attached and with proof of purchase.

- Exchanges can be arranged directly with New Zealand Uniforms.
- If you need to exchange an item for a different size we are also offering an exchange option at school, <u>by appointment</u>, on the following days and times: Tuesday 25 January—Friday 28 January 2022 12-3pm Tuesday 1 February—Friday 4 February 2022 12-3pm

SCHOOL UNIFORM GUIDELINES

All students attending Glen Eden Intermediate School are required to wear the official school uniform when travelling to, attending and travelling home from school. All students are expected to be clean and neatly dressed. Please ensure all items of uniform are clearly named.

GEIS School Uniform:

- Bottle green school culottes, skort or shorts
- White Polo shirt with the school logo worn out over the culottes/skort/shorts
- PE uniform: black shorts and green shirt as available from the School Shop.
- Plain black cap/bucket hat (during term 1 & 4)
- Optional—Bottle green lined Jacket, full zip with the school logo
- Optional—Black Polar fleece with school logo
- Optional—Black Waterproof Rain Jacket with school logo
- Optional—Black scarf with school logo

The only jewellery allowed is a watch and one pair of plain stud earrings.

NO makeup is allowed—this includes nail polish on fingernails and toenails.

Any singlet or undergarments must not be visible under the polo shirt or extend beyond the polo shirt sleeves. This means plain white with no logos showing through.

Raincoats may be worn to and from school on wet days. Around school the school fleece and/or jacket may be worn.

Hats are compulsory during term one and term four whenever students are outside. They are not to be worn inside.

Footwear:

Shoes: Must be plain black, leather lace ups (school shoe style not sports shoe), T-bar or Mary Jane style.

They are to be worn with white ankle socks; this means they must cover the ankle. Liners and other low cut sports socks are *not acceptable*.

Girls also have the option of wearing black opaque tights in the winter months.

Sandals: Must be plain black leather and have a back strap.

Shoes, sandals, tights and socks can be purchased at your preferred retail store
