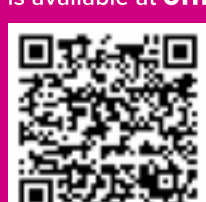
We encourage students to embrace the many opportunities available culturally, academically, in sports, and beyond - so they can grow, lead, and thrive.
